28th Annual Top Gun Soccer Tournament Tournament Team Invitation



Mira Mesa Soccer/AYSO Region 285 is proud to invite your team to the 28th Annual Top Gun Soccer Tournament

- Scope:** AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO and AYSO Affiliate teams only from all Areas/Sections across the USA. AYSO Affiliate teams includes but not limited to: AYSO Extra, AYSO Challenge, AYSO Select, AYSO Pacific Soccer Club, AYSO Matrix Soccer Club, and AYSO South Bay Matrix Club
- When:** Saturday, Sunday & Monday, May 26th through May 28th, 2018. There is a mandatory Team Registration meeting on May 25, 2018 for one team official.
- Where:** The tournament will be held at fields in Mira Mesa, a community of San Diego, California.
- Who:** AYSO boys and girls teams in birth year age divisions: 19U (2001-1999) and 16U (2003-2002) - 11v11, 18 players max; U-14 (2005-2004) - 11v11, 15 players max; U-12 (2007-2006) - 9v9, 12 players max; and, U-10 (2009-2008) - 7v7, 10 players max. All players must be registered to play in the AYSO 2017 primary season. Co-ed teams will be accepted in boys' divisions only.
- Teams that have larger normal roster size can request permission from the Top Gun Tournament Board **in advance** to bring their entire team but each player must play ½ of each game.
- GUEST PLAYERS WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED IN THE U-16 & U-19 divisions (3 maximum per team).**
- What:** Pool play tournament. Each team will play up to 4 games in pool play. The top teams will advance to the medal round on Monday afternoon. All games will be as follows: 60 min. for 19U & 16U, 50 min. for 14U & 12U, and 40 min for 10U. Medal round games durations will be regulation length for U-14, U-12, & U-10. Medal round games for U-19 & U-16 will be 35 minutes or regulation length (dependent on # of teams).
- Why:** The Tournament is being conducted as a fundraiser by Mira Mesa Soccer/AYSO Region 285 to raise funds for Field Development, Equipment, & Maintenance, and to provide Scholarship funds for youths.
- Awards:** All players and 2 coaches per team will receive a tournament t-shirt and pin. Medals will be awarded to finalist teams. A trophy will be presented to 1st place teams.
- Entry Fee, Refunds:** \$500 for 19U, 16U, & 14U; \$485 for 12U; and, \$435 for 10U. A full refund will be issued if tournament is cancelled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, no refund is provided unless a replacement is found.
- Referee Fee, Refunds:** \$375, refundable within **14 days of tournament completion provided that verification of ALL REFEREE ASSIGNMENTS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED**. Each team is required to provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover up to 4 games (maximum of 12 assignments) during the tournament. **PARTIAL REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN.**
- Rules:** A full set of the tournament rules are posted on the tournament website. Laminated ID Cards **are required** for players and coaches.
- Acceptance:** The application deadline is March 19th. Teams will be notified once their application has been received. Applications are then evaluated based on team competitive strength, referee team experience, & date the application forms & fees were received. Acceptance of teams will be decided & teams will be notified by March 26th. Teams applying without a referee team will be placed on a waiting list. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their fees returned or to be placed on the waiting list.
- How:** Fill-out entry applications and all necessary forms on the tournament website. Print these forms, obtain necessary signatures, and mail forms with your fees. Send **1** Region check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees along with the tournament application and team roster (guest/outside player forms, if necessary) to the Tournament Registrar at the address below. Your Regional Commissioner must sign application and team roster. Appropriate referee administrators must sign the application form in the referee section.
